HOME AND COMMUNITY BASED SERVICES (HCBS)

CLINICAL CONSULTANT OPPORTUNITY

I. Objectives:

Provide clinical oversight to HCBS staff regarding participants' progress toward the recovery and reacquisition of skills.

Perform clinical oversight while actively promoting an environment consistent with MHA's Cultural Equity Policy and WELCOME Orange.

IV. Qualifications:

- Mental Health Practitioner who is currently licensed by the NYS Education Department plus two years' experience providing direct services related to the treatment of mental illness and substance use disorders (SUD)
OR
- Social Worker who is currently licensed as a LMSW or LCSW by the NYS Education Department plus two years' experience providing direct services related to the treatment of mental illness and substance use disorders (SUD)
- Effective written and oral communication skills.
- Must be organized, self-motivated and have the ability to coordinate multiple tasks simultaneously.
- Ability to exercise sound judgment under crisis situations and to abide by regulations regarding confidentiality.
- Valid NYS Driver's License and ability to drive with current driving record acceptable for agency insurance coverage.
- Maintain current Liability Insurance.
- Must be clear and maintain an acceptable record under the Office of Mental Health (OMH) mandated criminal background check process.

V. Responsibilities:

- Provide periodic clinical supervision to the Habilitation Specialist, Psychosocial Rehabilitation Specialist, 2 Family Support Specialists and the Employment Program Specialist.
- Make recommendations for treatment and referrals as appropriate.
- Document clinical service delivery within 48 hours of program participant contact if applicable. Ensure that documentation meets all appropriate HIPAA and Medicaid guidelines including electronic health records.
- Provide periodic review of HCBS documentation to ensure compliance with the goals outlined on the Individualized Service Plan (ISP).
- Participate in or provide oversight in the development of the ISP, including establishing objectives, outcomes, etc.
- Provide resources for developing and refining interventions and strategies.
- Identify, refer, and advocate for program participant's needing specialty behavioral health services, and other services as needed.
- Communicate with HCBS Manager and HCBS program staff regarding caseload and service needs. Provide additional support as needed regarding complex cases.
