## Home and Community Based Services (HCBS)

*Helping individuals achieve recovery, resiliency and self-determination.*

## WHAT WE PROVIDE:

- **Psychosocial Rehabilitation:**

Wide-range of support services to promote independent living skills.

- **Habilitation:**

Services that help a person learn, keep, or improve skills that may not have developed on their own.

- **Family Support and Training:**

Training and support to the family in the treatment planning process.

*Staff are credentialed as New York State Family Peer Advocates. The focus of the service is on empowering family members to find their voice, acquire new skills and learn how to plan and partner effectively on behalf of their family member.*

- **Employment Services:**

- **Prevocational Services** are time-limited services that prepare a person for paid or unpaid employment.

- **Transitional Employment** helps to strengthen a person's work record and skills to help get employment.

- **Intensive Supported Employment** helps a person obtain and keep a job.

- **Ongoing Supported Employment** is provided after a person is employed.

## WHAT ARE HCBS SERVICES?

HCBS services provide opportunities for people with behavioral health issues to receive services in their own home or community. HCBS services are provided for individuals who are:

- HARP (Health and Recovery Plan) eligible
- Enrolled in Medicaid
- 21 years of age or older

**HARP** is managed care for adults with mental health or substance use needs.

HCBS services help to improve an individual's quality of life by providing assistance including:

- Getting and keeping a job
- Getting into school and graduating
- Managing stress and living independently
