Vocational Services

Supported Employment through ACCES-VR

The necessary ongoing support needed to obtain and maintain employment for individuals with disabilities. These supports are individualized and include on site job coaching, designed to help ensure success and satisfaction at work.

Participants learn work readiness skills, how to design a resume, how to interview for a job, and receive on the job training at businesses. We strive to place individuals in competitive employment, and work to ensure that program participants have training and job options that match their interests and abilities. Referrals to Mental Health Association in Orange County, Inc. (MHA) Supported Employment Services are obtained through ACCES-VR.

Extended Services

These services support the individual in maintaining employment. Services include on site job coaching and support to ensure continued employment success.

Hudson House

Vocational services are offered on-site at Hudson House. Hudson House is a psychosocial club which offers socialization, recreation, education, vocation, and life skills training to adults 18+ who have a mental illness.

The goal of Hudson House is to assist members in attaining enriched foundations in work, education, relationships, and activities of daily living.

Hudson House Programs

- Hudson House Day and Evening Social Club
- Transportation is provided for individuals in the City of Newburgh and surrounding areas.
- Supported Education
- Travel Activity Club
- Meals are served for those who qualify.
