Care Coordination



What we do:

Our Care Managers will be able to assist you with accessing medical and mental health services to improve your health and wellness.

We provide:

- Assistance with scheduling appointments and medical transportation.
- Consultation with primary care physician (PCP) and/or any specialists involved.
- Referral to peer services, supports groups, social services, and entitlement programs as needed.
- Coordination with treating clinicians to assure that services are provided and changes in treatment or medical conditions are addressed.
- Adherence to standard HIPAA laws by protecting your private information adequately.
- Work with your PCP and other providers to coordinate all of your physical and behavioral health care;
- Help you manage ongoing medical issues like diabetes, asthma, and high blood pressure;
- Identify resources you need that are located in your community;
- Help you with finding and/or applying for stable housing;
- Help you safely return home after a hospital stay; and
- Make sure you get follow up care, medications and other needed services

You are eligible if...

- **You have active Medicaid**
and
- **You have a need for service**
and
- **You have at least one of the following qualifying conditions:**
 - Two or more chronic medical conditions
 - A mental health diagnosis
 - You are HIV Positive
 - A combination of mental health, medical, and/or substance abuse diagnosis
